C. Race: 33 Maximum
- 9.4.13 - **Impound:** IMSA Technical Compound in the Paddock per the Technical Department.

- 11. **Pit Vehicles:** Pit vehicles must be operated by a licensed driver 18 years or more in age. Motorscooters and bicycles permitted in the Paddocks only. 10 MPH speed limit in Paddock and pit areas.
- 12. **False Grid:** Instructions pertaining to gridding, movement of racecars, crew and equipment provided at Team Manager and Driver Briefings. Teams must be familiar with procedures and follow the direction of IMSA and Event Officials.
- 13. **Spotter Passes:** Hard cards required. Further instructions at the Team Manager Briefing.
- 14. **Radio License Info:** All US based Teams must acquire a Short Term Radio License from Industry Canada to operate in Canada. Information at imsacompetitors.com.
- 15. **Facility Restrictions:** Teams must abide by the 2018 HIT Supplementary Regulations - Support Series at imsacompetitors.com.
- 16. **Parking Procedure:** Two (2) Passes per entered Car from Registration. Parking in the underground lot or any of the surrounding surface lots.
- 17. **Electric:** Showtech Power & Lighting, www.showtech.ca.
- 18. **Tickets:** Each Race entry receives two (2) general admission tickets (Sat. & Sun.). Tickets issued at IMSA Registration.
- 19. **Additional Information:** Additional maps, forms and information at imsacompetitors.com.
- 20. **Canadian Taxes:** Canada has a goods and services tax (GST) on many items such as accommodations and most goods to be used primarily outside Canada. Americans visiting Canada can keep receipts, file a claim and be reimbursed for the taxes. Information kits available at the border. Refund applications (Form GST176) can be obtained from Canada Customs and Revenue Agency, 800-959-2221 (From Canada and the US) or 613-952-3741 (Outside Canada and the US) or on-line at www.cra-arc.gc.ca.
- 21. **Helicopter:** Canadian law prohibits the dedicated placement of an on-site medical response helicopter.
- 22. **Track Shipping:** Packages or mail must NOT be sent to the circuit. Alternative arrangements required.
