# **Timing and Scoring Access**



- IMSA view monitors in Pit Lane
  - Reference pit lane screens for:
    - pit/in and pit/out times
  - IMSA view is official
- Series Pit Cart is located at Pit Out
- IMSA App (public)
- IMSA.TV (public)






- A team member must monitor the race control channel on the radio provided to you at all times.
  - 461.2000 do not transmit on this channel!
- All instructions will be given via this channel.
- If you are unclear on an instruction, or would like to relay a message to Race Control, please notify a pit official or go to the Series Pit Box via IM.
- A team member must be in pit lane w/radio communication to the driver anytime the car is on track.

### **Technical/Series Items**

- Parc Ferme/Post Tech. After qualifying and race, Officials will notify teams via radio of cars that need to report to Tech Inspection.
- In-car yellow light systems are mandatory. The receiver unit must be returned promptly at the end of every event to the Tech Trailer.
- Working and correctly identified Driver ID plugs are mandatory.
  Pit stop or Drive Through required to rectify.
- ICC located at base of Start/Finish building. After hours call 911
- No refueling under tents or without proper fire gear and extinguisher
- World Final licenses

# **Traffic Flow**

- Race Cars through false grid
- Exit through break at Race Control/ Medical
- Pit officials will direct cars forward of last break






Wide marked Lanes – Fast Lane and Transition Lane



Speed Limit 60KPH Pit boxes on right, transition lane middle and fast lane on left

# Pit Out / Pit Exit Closed Light

- Can line up at Pit Out for Practice and Qualifying
- If you choose to go to your pit box, wait for call on radio to release from your pit box
- Note where Pit lane speed limit ends and Pit closed light on driver's left





# Pit Out Merge



Do not cross yellow/green paint on pit out



Cars on track have right of way. Stay right all the way to turn One.

#### Safe Havens at Orange Overlaps



Multiple Safe Havens around track. Marked by Orange Overlaps.



Many can be reached by Fire and Rescue and tow trucks

### Pit In Merge/Pit Commit Line





Get right quickly after exit of Turn 14 to signal intention to pit.

# **Pit Lane Speed Start/Pit Closed Light**





# Pit In closed light – center of pit lane







- Speed Limit Pit Lane: 60 km/h All Sessions
- Pit Lane Distance (Line to Line): 13,524 inches / 1,127.0 feet / .213 Miles / .344 Kilometers. Takes 21 seconds at 60Km/h
- Obligatory Pit Stop Total Time for Two Driver Teams: 81 seconds
- Obligatory Pit Stop Total Time for Solo Driver Teams: 84 seconds
- Obligatory stop must take place between the 20:00:00 and 29:59 mark of event
- Maintain safe speed leaving pit lane, no excessive loss of speed



- Can line up at pit out or go to your pit box.
- Release from your pit box only after Race Control announces over the radio that you are released.
- If session is stopped (red flag) same release procedure as above.
- (2) 15-minute sessions separated by a five minute break sets the field for Race One & Two. At 1 minute to green, will announce on radio that 2<sup>nd</sup> group can line up at pit out.

A checkered flag will be displayed at the end of both qualifying sessions.

- Cars with two drivers will have only one driver participate in each qualifying session.
  - Driver in Q1 will be the starting driver for R1. Driver in Q2 will be the starting driver for R2.
