


# PADDOCK FLOW






# START LINE





# RESTART AND FINISH LINE







- Queue at Pit Exit or go to Pit Box
- Pit Box release
- > Red flagged
- > Short session

### PIT STOP INFO



- Pit Stop without fueling
  - No minimum pit stop time required
  - Maximum of 3 crew members over the wall

- Pit Stop with fueling
  - ➤ Minimum pit stop time of 2:30 minutes
  - ➢ Pit Lane distance is 15,803 inches, 1,316.9 ft, 401.396 meters. 24 seconds at 60 kph
  - Maximum of 5 crew members over wall
