6:05:00 PM	Checkered Flag
	After taking checker, overall winner and all cars slow to safety car speed no later than turn 13
	Race Control call: "Cars that have taken checker please slow to safety car speed"
	RC to announce any "TV special" car(s) needed for interviews via RC frequency
	Cool down lap
	RC to announce class winners, remaining podium finishers, and TV Special cars via Race Control frequency
AFTER ALL RACING CARS HAVE TAKEN CHECKERED FLAG	
6:10:00 PM	All cars enter pit lane, driver's left. IMSA Officials hand checkered flag to Driver of overall winning car.
	IMSA Officials direct all class winning cars to turn right at false grid opening. All class winning cars park at podium stage area as directed by IMSA Officials. 2nd, 3rd and TV Special cars are directed by IMSA Officials to park drivers right on pit lane. Drivers released to podium after TV interviews and as directed by IMSA Officials.
	All other finishing cars are directed to continue through pit lane, drivers left, and exit at pit out gate as directed by IMSA Officials.
Confetti shot	Class winning co-drivers, crew and team entrants go immediately to car in Victory Lane for interviews. TV to cue winning driver to exit car wearing Michelin hat. Confetti shot. Photographers get shots then TV start interviews. Once released by TV, class winning drivers and team entrants go to Victory Podium, stage left.
	IMSA staff confirm all drivers are stage left and all dignitaries and presenters are stage right
Media Center	All winners taken to media center by IMSA PR staff once all podium activities are complete
Lightning Plan	If lightning, victory podium will move to the Tufte Center
	Prepare for first podium, stage 6 bottles of champagne
