
## **GENERAL ON-TRACK**

- MUST HAVE CREW IN PIT BOX, LISTENING TO RACE CONTROL WHEN CAR IS ON-TRACK
  - Race Control Frequency 461.2000 DPL 432
- PIT-TO-CAR RADIO FREQUENCIES MUST BE REGISTERED WITH RACING ELECTRONICS PRIOR TO PRACTICE #1
- SLOW OR DISABLED CARS SHOULD FIND NEAREST AND SAFEST AVAILABLE ORANGE OVERLAP WHEN NECESSARY
- COMMUNICATIONS TO RACE CONTROL BY SPEAKING WITH PIT OFFICIALS
  - More information = best informed decisions




## PRE-RACE/FORMATION LAP

- REFER TO OFFICIAL SCHEDULE AND MINUTE-BY-MINUTE FOR FINAL TIMES AND EXPECTATIONS
- MOVE TO GRID ON PIT LANE, ECHELON FORMATION DRIVER'S LEFT
- ONE (1) FORMATION LAP
- PAIR UP AFTER EXITING T16 (NO MORE TIRESCRUBBING)


## **RACE START**

- ONE (1) FORMATION LAP
- PACK UP ON THE WAY TO T16
- PAIR UP EXITING T16
- STAY WITH SAFETY CAR
- NO ACCELERATION POINT
  - Polesitter to maintain steady speed until Green Flag
  - No passing until after your Car crosses the S/F line
  - P2 must maintain column until crossing the S/F line
- JUMP/FALSE START REVIEWED:
  - Gaps
  - Timed/Early Acceleration
  - Out of Line
  - Column Passing

## **ON-TRACK CONDUCT**

#### LOCAL YELLOW FLAGS

• No passing from point perpendicular to yellow flag to the point perpendicular to the following green flag

#### BLOCKING

- Defined as movement in reaction to the trailing car
- Defending increases responsibility

#### CONTACT/INCIDENT RESPONSIBILITY

- Review with Driver Advisor in RC
- Incidents under review announced over Race Control radio

#### COEXISTENCE

Maintaining awareness lessens margin for error, regardless of responsibility

#### COMMUNICATE REVIEW REQUESTS TO PIT OFFICIALS

Must provide time of day, location, and description of action to be reviewed

## **FULL COURSE YELLOW**

- RACE CONTROL RADIO, IN-CAR LIGHTS, TRACKSIDE LIGHTS, AND DOUBLE YELLOW FLAGS DISPLAYED
- SAFETY TRUCKS MAY BEGIN TO MOVE AS SOON AS RACE IS NEUTRALIZED
- LEADER TO SAFETY CAR SPEED, ALL CARS PACK UP RESPECT THE AREA OF INCIDENT/TRACK SERVICES PERSONNEL
  - Safety Car dispatches from pit exit
  - RC instructions regarding track condition over radio
- LIGHTS OUT BY TURN 16
  - Maintain SC speed, let SC get away, no more tire scrubbing after turn 16
- RESTART ACCELERATION ZONE TURN 17
  - · Passing on display of green flag

## **POST-RACE**

- ALL CARS ENTER PIT LANE
- ALL PODIUM CARS AND YOKOHAMA HARD CHARGER CONTINUE THROUGH PIT LANE AND DRIVE TO PODIUM LOCATED NEAR TURN 17-B.
- ALL DRIVERS MUST HAVE MASKS ON AND MAINTAIN 6' OF DISTANCE BETWEEN ONE ANOTHER
- NO CREW IN VICTORY LANE, MUST REMOVE CARS TO IMPOUND IMMEDIATELY
- ALL OTHER CARS CONTINUE AND EXIT PIT LANE AS DIRECTED BY OFFICIALS
