SAFETY ITEMS

PPE

- MUST be used at all times from load in to load out

PADDOCK EXPECTATIONS

- No more than twelve (12) people in paddock space
- Maintain social distance
- Restrooms located around the facility will be available for Teams
- Only one (1) Team member at IMSA Transporters Text Sarah in advance of coming to the truck
- No Team personnel in the IMSA Tech tent





PROCEDURAL ITEMS

MOTUL POLE AWARD

 GS and TCR pole winners need to report to the head of support pit lane for postqualifying interviews and photos in front of Motul Pole Award backdrop – must wear PPE

PRE RACE

- Refer to MxM All cars will be gridded on the support pit lane no grid walk
- Two formation laps once dispatched from the support pit lane

POST RACE

- Refer MxM All cars will enter T-16 pit lane
 - First, second, and third place will continue down pit lane and drive to podium, exit track at T17B.
 - IMSA Officials will direct cars as they enter T-17 B. Proceed with caution.
- All podium drivers must wear PPE in Victory Lane
- Crew remain outside of Victory Lane
- All other cars continue and exit Pit Lane as directed by Officials

ADDITIONAL ITEMS

LOAD IN / LOAD OUT

- Load-In: Drivers must be at truck and monitoring CB channel 40, no later than 30 minutes prior to load-in start.
- Load-Out: Transporters must NOT move until 5:00 pm on Fri., Nov. 13. All transporters must vacate the T16 Paddock by 12:00 midnight, Fri., Nov. 13.
- Paddock Tear-Down: May begin at 9:00 am on Fri., Nov. 13.


TRACK WALK

MERG/TIMS

DURING EVENT USES

- Engine Change
- Discontinue participation in Event <u>before</u> Race

AFTER QUALIFYING

- Request to change one (1) tire
- Notification of four (4) tire change
- Nominate Starting Driver within 30 minutes if you did not participate in qualifying

DURING RACE

Retire from Race



TECHNICAL ITEMS

DATA COLLECTION – GS

- All GS Entrants are required to upload team logger race data to the designated ShareFile location within 30 minutes at the end of a Race, as per IMPC CB #20-16
- Entrants are responsible to place all race data in an appropriate "Race Data" folder inside Team folder.
- If a Car is requested for post-race impound, both Team and Manufacturer representatives must be present at impound immediately after the race concludes for Team and ECU data collection.

DATA CARDS – TCR

- Will be issued during Safety Checks
- TCR Entrants must swap data card following Practice 2
- After Race TCR data card must be turned in with 30 minutes of completion of Race
- Entrants are responsible for fully functional Data Logger System during the Event






PADDOCK / PIT LANE FLOW DURING SESSIONS





OFFICIAL TRACK MAP






PIT COMMIT

MUST BE NOSE UP TO AND WHEELS TOUCHING THE DASHED WHITE LINE THAT DIVIDES THE RACETRACK FROM PIT ENTRY PRIOR TO THE PIT CLOSED LIGHT (ON TIRES AT DIVIDING POINT) ILLUMINATING IN ORDER TO BE CONSIDERED COMMITTED TO THE PITS.



PIT LANE SPEED LIMIT


PIT LANE SPEED LIMIT BEGINS AT RED PYLONS











 LIGHT SYSTEM




RACE

- TWO (2) FORMATION LAPS
- PACK UP FIRST TIME BY / PAIR UP OUT OF TURN 16
- STAY WITH SAFETY CAR
- SAFETY CAR ENTERS PITS
- P2 MUST MAINTAIN COLUMN UNTIL CROSSING THE S/F LINE
- ACCELERATION POINT (POLESITTER)
- JUMP / FALSE START REVIEWS
 - Gaps
 - Timed / Early Acceleration
 - Out of Line
 - Column Passing
 - It is NOT permitted to move from one column to the other prior to the Start/Finish line
- OFFICIAL RACE START IS SECOND TIME BY








STANDARD FULL COURSE YELLOW

- PITS CLOSED
- FULL COURSE YELLOW
- LEADER SAFETY CAR SPEED
- SAFETY CAR DISPATCHED TO OVERALL LEADER
- PASS AROUND (NO TIRE SCRUBBING)
- PITS OPEN (GS)
- PITS OPEN (TCR)



STANDARD FULL COURSE YELLOW

- EMERGENCY SERVICE CARS MUST D-T (NO GUARANTEE OF YELLOW)
 - Failure to take additional drive-through: stop plus 10 seconds
 - Non-emergency service taken: stop plus 60 seconds
- FINAL WAVE-BY (NO TIRE SCRUBBING)
- CARS WITH CLASS LEADER BEHIND PULL OUT, PASS LINE AND SAFETY CAR
- PITS OPEN (GS)
- PITS OPEN (TCR)
- GS CLASS SPLIT
- RESTART
- NOT IN EFFECT DURING FINAL 30 MINUTES OF RACE



SHORT FULL COURSE YELLOW

- SHORT (FIRST FCY WITHIN 15 MINUTES OF START OR RESTART FROM A STANDARD YELLOW, OR DURING FINAL 30 MINUTES OF A RACE)
- PITS CLOSED
- FULL COURSE YELLOW
- LEADER SAFETY CAR SPEED
- SAFETY CAR DISPATCHED FROM PIT OUT TO LEADER
- PASS-AROUND BEGINS (NO TIRE SCRUBBING)
- PITS REMAIN CLOSED
- NO FINAL WAVE-BY
- GS CLASS SPLIT



SHORT FULL COURSE YELLOW

- PITS OPEN AFTER THE LAST CAR PASSES PIT ENTRY AND THE RESTART IS ANNOUNCED BY RACE CONTROL
- RESTART
- EMERGENCY SERVICE CARS MUST DRIVE-THROUGH
 - Failure to take additional drive-through: stop plus 10 seconds
 - Non-emergency service taken: stop plus 60 seconds
