



## VICTORY LANE RUN-OF-SHOW | COVID-19 PROCEDURES

Below is an updated run-of-show for each Victory Lane, utilizing proper social-distancing and public health guidelines. 3-4 IMSA representative will be on-site to facilitate accordingly.

### Run-of-show:

- Winning cars proceed to Victory Lane
- Overall winning car pulls in
  - Driver puts on proper PPE / face mask then exits car
  - Driver puts on proper hat – hat will be pre-placed on driver's side panel
- Victory Lane is setup
  - Drivers wait in designated staging area, per class
  - Trophies and hats are set on stage at each podium place
    - 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> place areas are 6' apart
  - Any other track victory lane assets are put into place
- Photos of Hard Charger winner (Hat: Yokohama)
- Photos of top three drivers together (Hat: Yokohama)
- After trophy photos, drivers only report to Zoom interview station.

### Revisions:

- Drivers are permitted to spray champagne – with PPE and must maintain a social distance

### Additional Notes:

- Crew to wait outside of Victory Lane
- Everyone in Victory Lane must wear proper PPE / face mask

- 3-4 IMSA Representatives
- 1 Track Representative
- 1 Yokohama Representative
